**EVENT FORMAT:** This a Multi-tee Flighted, 4-man, 18-hole, best 2 of 4 Net team event

**ENTRY TYPE:** You may sign up as a single, twosome or foursome. Foursomes will play together but

not be on the same team. Twosomes will be paired at random to make a team of four.

**REGISTRATION:** \$70.00 Member or Guest\*\* (with Handicap) – includes skins.

\$31.00 MO Employee – includes skins

\*\* All Guest players must have an official handicap

- Hardcopies of this registration form along with cash or check payment may be placed in the men's club drop box in the Majestic Oaks Pro Shop

- Registration payments on the day of the event will incur a \$5 late fee.

### **EVENT TIME:** 8:00 am Shotgun

- Please check-in at least 30 minutes prior to tee time or an alternate will be allowed to play in your place, and entry fee may be forfeited.
- The registration table will close 30 minutes prior to shotgun start

#### **EVENT FORMAT:**

- Net Best Ball (2 of 4) counting two player's scores per hole.
- You may register as a single, twosome or foursome. Foursomes will play together but not be on the same team. Twosomes will be paired at random to make a team of four.
- The team score will be the two best of the four players' net scores for each hole.
- Each player must contribute a net score on at least 3 of the 18 holes.
- 85% of course handicap will be used as recommended by the USGA.

### **PAYOUTS:**

- Number of places/payouts determined by number of entrants.
- This event may be flighted depending upon number of entries.
- Individual nearies on all par 3's included.

**CROWN POINTS:** This event is worth 150 Crown Royal points.

SIGNATURE SHOWDOWN:

This event does count towards players' year-long Signature Showdown scorecard.

### **Tournament Rules**

#### **EVENT RULES:**

- This will be a best 2 of 4 net team event.
- While registering as a twosome, you will be paired up to generate a foursome.
- You will play with your registration partner, though you will not play with your pairing twosome as a foursome you will be playing against a competing twosome.
- For this format all players shall play their own ball through the hole.
- The players should record the **gross scores for each player** on each hole of the official score card.
- We will be using Golf Genius to submit scores in real time. A physical score card will still be required to turn in completed, attested, and signed to the scoring area within 15 minutes of completing the round.

## TEEING GROUNDS:

This is a **multi-tee** event. All play shall be from your year-long tee selection.

**TEE SHOTS:** All players will be playing their own ball throughout this competition.

**ONE BALL RULE:** The one ball rule is **NOT** in effect for this event.

### **NOTES:**

- Player scores will be recorded as "Competition" scores.
- USGA rules will govern all play except where modified by this format
- Local rules sheets will be available at the registration table.
- The one ball rule is **NOT** in effect for this event.
- Each player's current USGA handicap the day before the event will be used.
- The handicap committee will review & may adjust all handicaps prior to the event.
- Players without a USGA handicap index will be reviewed by the handicap committee.

# LOCAL ETIQUETTE:

- **Keep Pace** with the group in front of you.
- Wait to play until the players in front of you are out of range.
- **Replace** your divots or fill with sand/seed mix in the fairways.
- **Smooth** all marks made in sand hazards, leaving rakes in sand hazard.
- **Keep** power carts away from all tee boxes, hazards, and greens.
- Fix damage to the greens, even if it is not yours
- Leave the putting green as soon as you have holed out.
