EVENT TIME: 7:30 AM Breakfast & Closing Meeting

- A hot buffet-style breakfast (included with your entry fee) will be served in the Majestic Oaks Clubhouse
- The closing meeting will coincide with the breakfast, we will be voting on new MOMC board members for 2020 and any other club-wide issues

9:00 AM Shotgun

- Please check-in 30 minutes prior to tee time or an alternate will be allowed to play in your place, and entry fee may be forfeited
- The registration table will close 30 minutes prior to shotgun start

EVENT DETAILS:

- All players will compete in the same flight
- 100% of course handicap to be used for Net scores

ELIGIBILITY: Tournament and prizes:

 All MOMC players in good standing are eligible to play in the event and compete for tournament prizes

Crown Royal Drawing Prizes:

- To qualify for the drawing, players need to have accumulated 1750 Crown Points throughout the 2019 MOMC season
- Playing in the Closer will add to your Crown Royal point total
- Those MOMC players who have qualified for the Crown Royal drawing must compete in the event and turn in a completed scorecard to be eligible for the drawing prizes
- Players must be present to win drawing prizes

PAYOUTS:

- Payouts will be for individual low gross and low net players (cannot win both gross and net prizes)
- Number of places/payouts determined by the number of entrants
- Optional skins, and/or other games available at registration table
- Individual nearies on all par 3's included

CROWN POINTS: This event is worth 150 Crown Royal points.

Tournament Rules

EVENT RULES:

- For this format, all players will play their own ball for 18-holes per day
- The players should record the **gross scores** on each hole of the official score card
- Players should turn in completed, signed, and attested scorecards to the scoring area **within**15 minutes of completing the round
- Players must be present and turn in a completed scorecard to be eligible for Crown Royal drawing prizes

TEEING GROUNDS:

This is a **multi-tee** event. All play shall be from your year-long tee selection.

TEE SHOTS: All players will be playing their own ball throughout this competition.

ONE BALL RULE: The one ball rule is **NOT** in effect for this event.

EARNING CROWN POINTS:

The table below lists all of the ways to earn Crown Royal points throughout the MOMC season:

1-Day Events	150 points/event	TN or WN Event	50 points/event
2-Day Events	350 points/event	Skills Night	100 points
9 Hole Event + 1 st Time Guest	50 points/event	New Member Referral	150 point/member
Spring Fling + 1 st Time Guest	250 points	Par 3 Event	100 points
Sum Social + 1 st Time guest	250 points	16-man or Senior 8-man	50 points/season
MO Shop Events	50 points/event	Other MN golf events	50 points/event

NOTES:

- Player scores will be recorded as "Tournament" scores
- USGA rules will govern all play except where modified by this format
- Local rules sheets will be available at the registration table
- The handicap committee will review & may adjust all handicaps prior to event
- Players without a USGA handicap index will be reviewed by the handicap committee

LOCAL ETIQUETTE:

- **Keep Pace** with the group in front of you
- Wait to play until the players in front of you are out of range
- **Replace** your divots, or fill with sand/seed mix in the fairways
- Smooth all marks made in sand hazards, leaving the rakes in the hazards
- **Keep** power carts away from all tee boxes, hazards, and greens
- Fix damage to the greens, even if it is not yours
- Leave the putting green as soon as you have holed out
