FORMAT:

ENTRY TYPE:

Sign up as an individual, teams formed via Computer Blind Draw (ABCD)

REGISTRATION:

\$70.00 Member* – includes skins \$31.00 MO Employee* - includes skins

- Registration closes at 6:00 pm Thursday prior to event
- Payment must accompany entry form
- Registration payments on day of the event will incur a \$5 late fee

EVENT TIME: 8:00 AM Shotgun

- Please check-in at least 30 minutes prior to tee time or an alternate will be allowed to play in your place, and entry fee may be forfeited
- The registration table may/may not be set up.

EVENT DETAILS:

- All play will be from the Tournament tees.
- Team handicaps will be calculated based on 90% of each player's course handicap. from the tournament tees
- The team score will the best 3 of 4 Net scores for the hole
- Must use at least 3 tee shots from each team member

PAYOUTS:

- Payouts will be for low Net team score
- Number of places/payouts determined by the number of entrants
- This event may be a flighted event depending upon number of entries.
- Individual nearies on all par 3's included

Tournament Rules

EVENT RULES:

- 1. In a shamble event, all team members tee off on each hole and then decide which tee shot they like the best and mark the spot with a tee or ball marker.
- 2. The other team members pick up their balls and place them within **one club length** (no nearer the hole) of the marked spot.
- 3. If the ball you choose to play is in a hazard (sand, water, etc.), the rough, or out of bounds, you cannot drop the ball outside of the hazard or rough even if relief is within one club length away.
- 4. If the selected tee shot comes to rest on the green, the placed ball must be played from as close as possible to the marked spot (no closer to the hole).
- 5. From the selected tee shot, each team member then plays out the hole with their own ball for their own individual score.
- 6. The team should record the **gross scores** for all four players on each hole on the official score card.
- 7. We will be using Golf Genius to submit scores in real time. A physical score card will still be required to turn in completed, attested and signed to the scoring area within 15 minutes of completing the round.
- 8. The team score will be the best 3 of 4 Net scores for the hole.

COURSE DETAILS:

All play shall be from the **Tournament tees** (69.5/130)

TEE SHOTS:

Each player's tee shot must be used at least three times during the 18-hole competition.

NOTES:

- USGA rules will govern all play except where modified by this format
- Local rules sheets will be available at the registration table
- The one ball rule is **NOT** in effect for this event.
- Each player's handicap index the day before the event will be used
- The handicap committee will review & may adjust all handicaps prior to event
- Players without a USGA handicap index will be reviewed by the handicap committee

LOCAL ETIQUETTE:

- **Keep Pace** with the group in front of you
- Wait to play until the players in front of you are out of range
- Replace your divots
- Smooth all marks made in sand hazards, leaving rakes in sand hazard
- **Keep** power carts away from all tee boxes, hazards, and greens
- Fix damage to the greens, even if it is not yours
- Leave the putting green as soon as you have holed out
