1964 - land acquired for golf course - Ray Larowe

>>purchased family farm of John Vilina

>>Original name: Golden Tee Country Club

>>Originally a 9 hole course north & east of clubhouse

>>used to be private course

1971 - Became 18 hole course

1972 - New name - Majestic Oaks Country Club

1975 - Executive course renovated

1976 - Majestic Oaks rated in Top 50 public golf course in United States

1980's - Joe Duffy Celebrity Golf Tournaments played at Majestic Oaks

1983-1987 - Minnesota Vikings Celebrity Golf Tournaments at Majestic Oaks

1985 - University of Minnesota Lady Gopher Golf & Tennis invitational held

1990 - Lary Carlson purchased more land to build another 18 hole course

1991 - Crossroad Course ready for play

1991 - Executive Course added

1997 - Big storm took down 1000 trees

1999 - 1st year of Annual Par 3 Tournament

2004 - Leveled bunkers on Platinum course hole 18 in October

2005 - Pro Shop renovation

2005 - 1st year Wednesday 9 hole night league

2005 - 1st year of Chili Open Tournament

2008 - Renamed courses

>>*Platinum to Signature*

>>*Gold Course to Crossroads*

2008 - Big storm took down more trees

2011 - 1st Crown Royal Tournament held

2011-2013 - Snow Golf introduced

2012 - Boot Hockey begins in cart barn

2013-2014 - Driving range rebuilt

2014 - Foot golf introduced on Executive Course

2014 - 1st year Tuesday 9 hole night league

2015 - 1st year Tuesday & Wednesday night events

2018 - Clubhouse renovation

2020-2021 - COVID

2022 - over 100 trees removed
